

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-112**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REEDLEY  
DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO REGULATE TRAFFIC SIGNS,  
WARNING DEVICES, STRIPING, REGULATORY SIGNS, AND  
RELATED FACILITIES TO THE TRAFFIC SAFETY COMMISSION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Reedley as follows:

1. That the City Council of the City of Reedley hereby delegates the authority to approve and authorize installations of the following traffic signs, warning devices, striping, regulatory signs, and related facilities to the Traffic Safety Commission in accordance with Section 6-3-1(B) of the City of Reedley Municipal Code:

- A. Parking restrictions within parking zones including time limits, loading zones, no parking areas, and similar parking restrictions.
- B. Pedestrian lane locations.
- C. Designated stop sign and yield right-of-way locations.
- D. Prohibited U-turn locations.
- E. Street striping changes.
- F. Visibility problems.

2. The Traffic Safety Commission shall consult with the City Engineer in carrying out the above duties.

3. The City Manager, or his designee, shall be authorized to maintain, replace, or improve existing traffic regulatory devices in accordance with the directives of the Traffic Safety Commission.

4. The City Manager, or his designee, shall maintain a listing of all resolutions and administrative actions to install regulatory devices in accordance with City of Reedley Ordinance No. 660, and shall, from time to time, advise City Council of such actions.


5. This resolution shall become effective on the effective date of Ordinance No. 96-008.

This foregoing resolution is here adopted this 13th day of August, 1996, by the following vote:


