

Junior Rec Leader Responsibilities

As a Junior Rec Leader you will primarily function in assisting the paid staff with their responsibilities in their various programs. This could include a variety of duties such as: preparation and set-up for art activities, demonstrating a specific skill or move, preparation of snack, referring a game, assisting with decorating, or clean up of activities. These duties are all part of the job and should be approached with a cheerful attitude.

By far the greatest portion of your time will be spent supervising individual or groups of children engaged in activities. It is certainly permissible, and even desirable that you participant with them. Please keep in mind however, that you are there in a leadership role, and should be modeling the types of behaviors that we would like to show.

Specifically, those behaviors are:

- Being courteous to participants and fellow leaders.
- Paying attention to leaders and following directions.
- Being respectful to all participants.
- Encouraging others
- Being enthusiastic
- Complimenting others
- Helping others who are having difficulties
- Giving positive feedback
- Being kind
- Displaying good sportsmanship
- Having fun
- Eating only at lunch and snack time
- Not using cell phone while working
