TITLE: PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENTAL FEES AND CHARGES FOR SERVICES IN THE CITYWIDE MASTER FEE SCHEDULE (NO ACTION)

### RECOMMENDATION

That the City Council hold a public hearing on proposed amendments to certain Departmental fees and charges in the Citywide Master Fee Schedule as presented in the attached fee schedule, to take effect June 1, 2016. A public hearing notice was published in the Reedley Exponent on March 31, 2016. The amended Master Fee Schedule will be brought forward for City Council review and approval on April 26, 2016.

### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The attached Master Fee Schedule is categorized by the individual Departments in charge of assessing and collecting the fee(s). The current fee charged by the City is shown in one column along with any proposed amendments next to it. All changes are shown in **bold font and italicized** for ease of review. Any removal of fees has been shown in **strikethrough**. The attached Master Fee Schedule is intended to include all fees currently charged by the City; although in some cases a fee may not be included if it is established by the State of California or otherwise stipulated in the Reedley Municipal Code. Although the City will review the Master Fee Schedule on an annual basis, from time to time it may be necessary to bring individual amendments forward. This practice, although normal in municipalities, will be minimized as much as possible. The following section summarizes changes to Department fees.

All approved fee revisions are proposed to take effect June 1, 2016, after being brought forward for approval at the regularly scheduled Council meeting on April 26, 2016. The Master Fee Schedule is posted on the City website for easy public and staff access.

The attached schedule is a compilation of current fees charged by the City for services and products provided by the City; and is referred to as the Master Fee Schedule. A best practice of municipal governments is to review all fees on an annual basis and publish the Master Fee Schedule annually. This insures that multiple objectives are met, such as:

- The Council and public are informed and have the opportunity to participate in the fee review process;
- Cost recovery ratios for specific fees are reviewed;
- Changes in constituent use and/or demand for services is reviewed annually; and
- Additional revenue from fee revisions can be quantified and built into the following year's budget to offset increasing or decreasing costs of providing certain services.

## **BACKGROUND**

The annual review of fees is a key component to maintaining financial control, equitably pricing services and offerings, and identifying core programs, facilities and services for an agency. Critical to this undertaking is the support and buy-in of elected officials, advisory boards, staff and, most importantly, of citizens. A regular review of fees usually mitigates the large increases to fees necessary when it is discovered years later that a particular fee or group of fees is not meeting cost recovery targets.

When reviewing City fees, it is important to understand who is benefiting from a specific service to determine how that service should be paid for. The basic premise used by many agencies is that the higher the benefit is to an *individual* from a City service, the higher the cost recovery ratio should be; and the more a service benefits the *community* as a whole, the lower the cost recovery ratio should be (or in some cases no fee at all).

It is also important to note that reviewing the fee schedule does not always mean fees will be increased. In some cases, fees are recommended to be lowered because the cost of providing that particular service has fallen due to operating efficiencies. In other cases, individual fees may be lowered to bring them in line with fees for comparable services or completely removed because the service is no longer provided. And finally, revisions may take the form of text changes to how a fee is presented in the document; either to clarify its purpose or specify policies affecting collection of the fee.

## **PROPOSED FEE REVISIONS**

The following discussion summarizes proposed changes to fees by category or program area in the order in which they appear in the Master Fee Schedule:

### Event Permits - Yard Sales

The City has an existing Yard Sale permit fee of \$10.00. The current text in the Master Fee Schedule specifies that the permit is good for one to three days, however it does not fully specify the parameters of the permit as set forth by Reedley Municipal Code Section 3-5-4, which states: "The maximum number of such sales at said address shall be limited to two (2) per year while the land is vested in the same ownership." There is no change to City practices with the inclusion of this additional language, and only seeks to align the fee schedule with the applicable ordinance.

### Fireworks Stand Security Deposit Fee

The City currently charges \$100.00 for a Fireworks Stand permit, and \$50.00 for a fully refundable security deposit. It was found that the refundable security deposit was not included in the fee schedule, therefore Staff is recommending approval to add it. The security deposit is charged to make sure the organization takes down their stand in a timely manner and leaves the site clean.

### Park Rental Fees – Hourly Clean Up Fee

When various park sites are reserved for private use, the City charges an hourly 'Clean Up' fee that is only charged if the person or group that used the facility leaves it dirty. The cost is taken from their security deposit. The Clean Up fee for various facilities is currently \$15.00, \$17.00, \$25.00 and \$30.00; however the actual cost for any reservable facility (based on current staff and overhead rates) is \$30.00 per hour. \$30.00 is the current hourly Maintenance Fee charged for the Community Center, so this change would make all facilities the same.

#### Youth Sports Late Registration Fee

Over the past couple of years staff has noticed that the late fee is not substantial enough to encourage parents to register on time. Due to the number of parents who try to register after the registration due date, this causes substantial difficulty for staff to accommodate late players to play. Staff is proposing to leave the early registration fee of \$45.00 and registration fee of \$50.00 as is, but increase the late registration from \$55.00 to \$70.00. The reason for this increase is to cover the additional staff time and cost it takes to work with a small number of players when they come in late. There is an additional cost to ordering uniforms late after the big order has been placed. Staff has also seen an increase in the staff time for recruiting additional coaches, contacting players off the wait list and getting them in to register, adjusting rosters and notifying coaches of changes to their team. This is all happening after the bulk of the work is done for the players who signed up on time and have been placed on teams. The goal of Community Services staff is that every child who would like to play has that opportunity, and increasing the late fee will help encourage parents to register on time. Staff has reviewed the late fee penalty in other cities, and Clovis District Recreation charges \$120.00 for regular registration and \$150.00 for late registration for the same youth sports programs. City of Visalia charges \$67.00 for regular registration and charges a \$10.00 late fee when registered after the date. This increase would only affect the parents who miss the early and regular registration dates leading up to the due date.

#### Adult Sports Security Deposit

A \$100.00 non-refundable security deposit is proposed for Adult Sports teams (softball & basketball) that would like to secure their spot on the game schedule. Due to the team managers collecting money from their players to pay for their registration fee, the manager doesn't always have the full fee at the time of registration. Managers are allowed to make payments up to the start of their first game. The \$100.00 deposit would allow Community Services staff to add the team to the game schedule even though the fee has not been paid in full by the time the schedule is made. Due to the time it takes to make the schedule and the affect it would have if a team at the last minute decides to drop out, the \$100.00 deposit would be nonrefundable.

#### Easter Carnival

Staff proposes to eliminate the reference to the Easter Egg Carnival in the Master Fee Schedule. There are no charges for the event and the Community Services Department no longer gives out tickets. The event is free to the public with no limitations.

#### Building Permit Fee – Photovoltaic Plan Check

Staff is proposing a new Photovoltaic Plan Check fee of \$40.00 be created that is designated specifically to small residential rooftop photovoltaic systems. Pursuant to AB 2188 and City of Reedley Ordinance 2015-004, the Building Division is required to provide expedited plan checking services for such projects. Currently, such systems are charged a flat rate of \$25.00 under the City's generic "Electric Plans without a Building Permit" plan check fee. After analysis of how the City's current fees compare to surrounding communities, it was determined a separate, flat rate plan check fee, would offset the increased cost of providing expedited service as required by State law, and would still allow the City to remain comparable to other public agencies.

#### Building Permit Fee - Photovoltaic

Staff is proposing that the Photovoltaic Fee charged per system be increased from \$130.00 to \$200.00. The high volume of photovoltaic projects and subsequent inspections has created a large demand for staff time. After analysis of how the City's current fees compare to surrounding communities, it was determined an increase in our flat rate fee would help to offset the increased cost of providing expedited

service as required by State law, and again, allow the City to remain comparable to other public agencies.

#### Water Meter / Radio Pricing

Staff requests a text change to fees established for the purpose of selling water meters to the public, specifically the reference to the model names since they are brand specific. The existing "Cost + 5.0%" fee will remain unchanged. Additionally, two of the meter sizes will be removed since they are now redundant.

#### Administrative Review Fee for Non-Profit Entities

Administrative Reviews are conducted by the Community Development Department to ensure that the proposed business activities for a specific location are in compliance with current zoning, ordinance or other land use requirements. A reduced Administrative Review fee for non-profit organizations of \$25.00 is proposed from the existing \$100.00. The \$25.00 fee would be available as long as proof of non-profit status is presented upon application submittal. Although the current fee of \$100.00 is full cost recovery for this service, the reduced rate provides an incentive for non-profit organizations to locate to Reedley and enhance and assist the community.

#### Conditional Use Permit (CUP) – New Development Project

Staff is also proposing that the "CUP – New Development Project" fee be increased from \$1,725 to \$2,100. According to the current Master Fee Schedule, the application fees for Conditional Use Permits and Site Plan Review (SPR) Applications are the same. The current SPR application fee offsets the cost to process the application, however the current CUP application fee does not because the Conditional Use Permit process requires a Public Hearing. A Public Hearing consists of publishing a notice in the Reedley Exponent, notifying surrounding property owners, preparing staff reports and an agenda packet, and holding the Public Hearing itself. All of these components consume more staff time and resources than a typical SPR. Staff estimates that the additional costs to prepare for the Public Hearing equate to \$375.00.

#### Engineering - Improvement Plan Check Fee

A modification of the Improvement Plan Check Fee is proposed, transitioning the fee from a graduated percentage of the cost of the Engineers Estimate of construction costs to a flat fee. The current fee is 2% of first \$20,000; plus 1.5% of amount over \$20,000. The proposed flat fee is \$650.00, which is based on past improvement plan checking efforts typically taking the same number of hours and staff. In other words, a higher estimate of construction costs does not always translate into more staff hours required to complete the plan check. The Engineering Division is currently tracking time spent on each improvement plan check, and will be evaluating the proposed fee at the end of next fiscal year to determine if the amount covers the level of staff time required.

#### Door to Door Hawking Fees

Fees for 'Door to Door Hawking' have not been evaluated nor have any changes been made in many years. The Police Department handles all requests, which involves collecting information from the applicant, conducting a background check, interviewing the applicant, issuing an ID card, and notifying the community. The cost to conduct this process currently exceeds the established fee of \$150.00 per year + \$10.00 per individual; however staff proposes to leave the \$150.00 fee as is, but remove the \$10.00 fee so that the \$150.00 applies per individual since the staff time and services required are the same whether the organization has one or several solicitors, since each applicant is reviewed individually.

### **Wastewater Treatment Plant Laboratory Service Fees**

The City's Wastewater Treatment Plant has a laboratory that is certified through the State of California Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program. It is able to perform several Wet Chemistry and Microbiological Analysis, which may be beneficial from time to time to the local real estate community, well drilling facilities and to the public in general. Staff requests to establish a new section of fees that would allow the City to accommodate requests for testing, which are expected to be primarily for water testing. The proposed menu of fees are full cost recovery, so no non-Reedley residents would be subsidized, and the fees are comparable to private sector labs. Staff estimates that only a handful of requests will be received per year, and the City will have the right to refuse service if staff is dealing with more urgent matters.

### **Solid Waste Text Changes**

Prior to the City taking over curbside recycling services, the City provided two refuse containers, one brown and one green. A private hauler provided the blue recycling container. Now that the City provides all three containers, the fee schedule needs to be amended to reflect three containers. Also the container services for residential accounts will be updated to reflect missing word "yard" waste can in the description of containers provided by the City. None of the proposed text amendments affect billing rates or collection practices of the City.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

The majority of the revised fees will generate additional revenue to the City to offset the increased costs of providing those services. The anticipated level of new revenue for each service/operation will be incorporated into the next year's budget.

### **PRIOR COUNCIL ACTIONS**

The City Council last adopted revisions to the Citywide Master Fee Schedule in April 2015, including amending departmental fee and charges for services. Prior to April 2015, the last time fees were comprehensively reviewed and considered was in April 2014.



### Municipal Airport:

#### Fees and Policies

No person shall park any aircraft on the Reedley Municipal Airport or at any hangars or facilities located thereon, nor shall use the facilities of the Reedley Municipal Airport unless arrangements therefore have been made in accordance with the schedule of rates and charges referred to herein, or unless contractual arrangements therefore have been made with the City. No person shall conduct any activity upon the Reedley Municipal Airport which may be specifically provided for by the rates set forth herein, unless and until suitable contractual arrangements have been made with the City of Reedley.

#### Aircraft Parking

Daily rates shall apply to commercial aircraft parked in excess of eight hours and to non-commercial aircraft parked in excess of 24 hours. Aircraft of lessees parked on their leased premises and aircraft owned and operated by the Federal Government are excluded. Payment for monthly reserved parking space is due and payable in advance for each calendar month. Payment of the daily aircraft parking charges shall be made prior to departure of aircraft. Accounts started during the last seven calendar days of the month shall be billed effective the first day of the following month.

Designated areas for privately-owned hangars shall be made available by the Airport Manager for the location of hangars. The model and type of hangar shall be approved by the Airport Manager. Individual land leases for the construction of hangars by individuals or firms shall be permitted and are to be coordinated by the Airport Manager.

#### Payment

For standard tiedowns, the initial rent shall include first month's rent, plus deposit equal to one month's rent. For all T-Hangars, initial payment shall include first month's rent and deposit equal to one month's rent plus a \$100 cleaning deposit. Thereafter, monthly rent shall be due and payable in advance.

#### Commercial Operator Fees

All non-based commercial operators, except operators of transient aerial applicator aircraft, shall pay a basic operator's fee of \$40.00 per calendar month, in advance, plus an additional charge of \$20.00 per month for each aircraft used by said operators, if any, with a gross weight from 1 through 6,000 pounds, and an additional charge of \$5.00 per month for each 1,000 pounds or fraction thereof over 6,000 pounds. Transient aerial applicator aircraft shall be charged at a rate of \$20.00 per aircraft per day while using the Reedley Municipal Airport. Transient aerial applicator aircraft are hereby defined as all aircraft used for aerial application purposes by persons who are not fixed-based operators at the Reedley Municipal Airport.
