## YARD ENCROACHMENT APPLICATION

(\$150 Application Fee)

Front yards or rear yards on lots proposed for residential development may be less than the required setback, provided that a written request and site plan are submitted. Applicant requesting a front or rear yard encroachment permit application may have that request processed independently of or concurrently with a site plan review application and/or building permit. Submittal of a site plan and/or building permit may cause a review of planning and building permit activity for the subject property to ensure compliance with the Reedley Municipal Code (RMC).

## **Guidelines:**

- Encroachment into any side yard shall be prohibited.
- The front or rear yard encroachment shall not be less than the required side yard for the zone district where the site is located. (Typically 5 feet for an interior lot in the R-1-6 Zone District)
- Space equal to the reduction shall be provided elsewhere on the lot, exclusive of any required yard area. No structures shall be located or constructed within the replacement space.
- A yard encroachment granted shall run with the land and shall continue to be valid upon a change of ownership.
